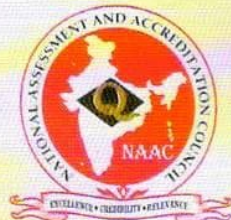

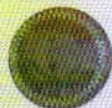

## **Bachelor of Law (B.A.LL.B.)**

**Intake: 240**

**(5 Years Full Time Integrated Course)**

B.A.LL.B. program is an integrated dual degree course, which is a combination of Bachelor's degree course in Arts (B.A.) together with the Bachelor's degree course in Law. The duration of this course shall be of five (5) academic years starting from the month of July of every year. The duration of this course is distributed over ten (10) semesters.

A student who successfully completes the first three (3) years of this course shall be eligible for the award of the Degree in B.A. (Academic Law). A student who successfully completes five (5) years shall be awarded with the degree of B.A.LL.B. and will be eligible to become a professional lawyer.



## **Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.)**

**Intake: 60**

**(3 Year Full Time Course)**

The B.B.A. program is a strong and integrated course, which give the students a lasting perspective and capability to innovate on the job. The Course imparts knowledge and develops specialization skills to foster the attitudes essential for the growth of the students to make them responsible and successful business managers in today's competitive corporate world.



## **Bachelor of Computer Application (B.C.A.)**

**Intake: 60**

**(3 Year Full Time Course)**

The B.C.A. program is in a great demand across the world. The reason behind this is the fast growing information technology and communication systems have become critical components of almost every company's strategic plan. The companies who want to take an advantage of the new information technologies and communication systems require expert professionals, who can apply computer science principles to solve the problems produced by the interface between business and technology. This course is designed to cater to the needs of the global Software Industry. It aims at imparting in-depth knowledge in software as well as in hardware concepts and their practical applications.







## Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.)\*

(3 Year Full Time Course)

Intake: 60

B.Com. program is one of the few courses which, despite being a traditional one, still find takers in the student community due to its application-oriented approach. Although perceived to be a vanilla course outside the periphery of the institute, the course being offered here is anything but is designed keeping in mind the changing landscape of commerce industry and the implications arising out of it. The students are groomed to do well in professional entrance exams such CA, CS, ICWA, Civil Services and the likes. Not only this, the students are given an exposure to soft skills, presentation finesse (a prerequisite for today's corporate environment), professional communication and office etiquettes, a far cry from the traditional commerce courses, which, in turn, prepare them well to face the challenges of the future. In short, the students have to explore this course to realize the significance of it.

10 + 2 pass in any discipline with 45% marks (Mathematics is a compulsory subject for B.C.A. course), relaxation and reservations will be given as per the rules of C.C.S. University. Admissions directly on first come first services or as per university guidelines.

# What after Graduation ??

## Bachelor of Law (LL.B.)

(3 Year Full Time Course)

Intake: 240

It is an undergraduate, or bachelor degree in law or can be said as a pioneer course in the field of law. This course is designed to develop a critical awareness of the common law legal tradition and be able to apply analytical and problem-solving skills in a range of legal and nonlegal settings. This will also help in enhancing key skills of communication, information literacy, analysis and arguments.

Earlier, this course was based on yearly examination pattern but now recently the C.C.S. University has changed its outlook and has been converted to semester examination pattern. This course is distributed over six (6) semesters starting from July of every year.



## Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)

(2 Year Full Time Course)

Intake: 100

Ministry of Human Resource and Development, Government of India has sponsored "SERVE SIKSHA ABHIYAN" and RIGHT OF EDUCATION ACT that will require recruitment of several lakhs of teachers which is why B.Ed. program aims to prepare effective teachers who are capable of responding to the changing needs of the present era. In past, B.Ed. course was known as Bachelor of Training (B.T.).



It is a course offered for those who are interested in pursuing career in teaching and related fields. Special emphasis is given to the all round development of the students through educational tours, seminars and modern educational technology. Importance has been given to participation and organization of co - curricular activities by the students in various events.

## Basic Training Certificate (B.T.C.)

(2 Year Full Time Course)

Intake: 50

The quality of the education system plays a major role in the development of the country as it builds up the human resources for the future. But the substance of a vibrant educational system depends to a large extent on the quality of teaching at the elementary level. This course in the field of education are increasingly becoming popular as recruitment board of primary teachers in various Indian States regard B.T.C. as a part of the minimum eligibility criteria for the appointment of primary teachers.







## Admission & Eligibility

Graduation in any discipline with 45% marks for LL.B., Graduation in any discipline with 50% marks for B. Ed. and B.T.C. Relaxation and reservations will be given as per the rules of C.C.S. University. Admissions directly on first come first services or as per university guidelines for LL.B. For B.Ed. and B.T.C. as per Govt/University admission process.

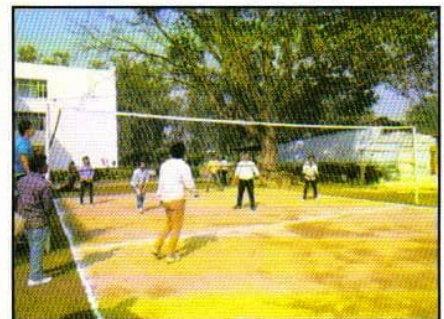
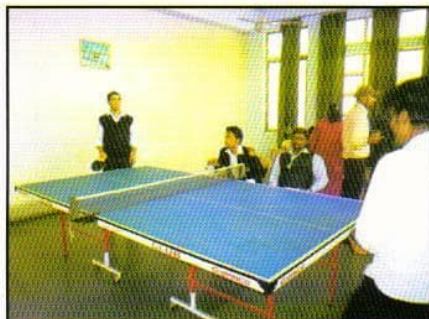
## Lecture Room

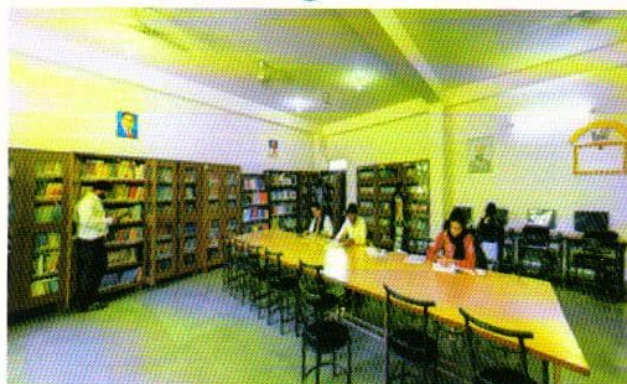
## Library

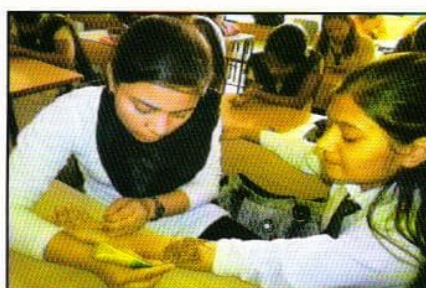




## Social and Cultural Programs

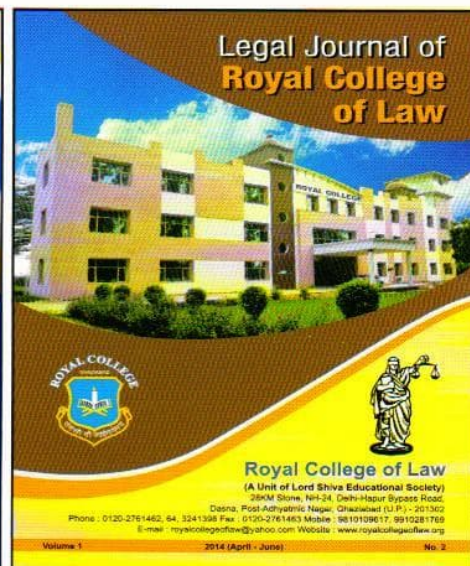
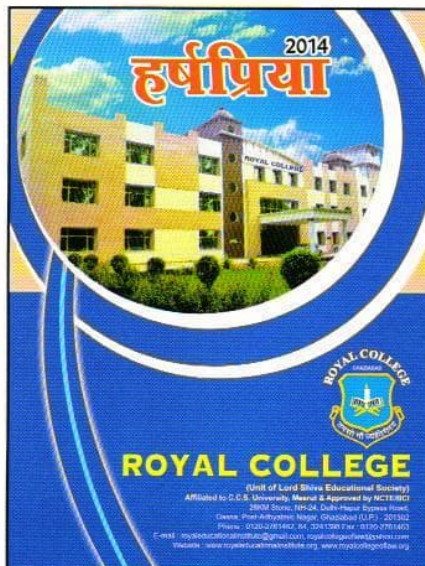


## Publications- Journals and Magazines
